#### OT Cab Co. 316.283.2960

Office hours - 6:00am - 5:00pm (last call - 4:30pm)
Cost:

- \$4.75 per ride, regular hours (6a 5p, Mon-Fri; 8a -1p, Sat) within Newton
  - \$4.75 base rate; extra charge for additional riders or stops
- Discount cards are available to income-qualified individuals at the Harvey County Department on Aging
- ♦ Base rate is \$18.75 after-hours and outside Newton

Provides or assists general and medical related transportation in the following situations:

- Harvey Interurban (HI) Bus, by appointment, for shopping, personal appointments and recreation, for Harvey County residents
  - Call for appointment or information, 8a 5p, Mon Fri: 284-6802 or 866-680-6802.
  - A <u>trip may not be wholly within Newton, it must</u>
     <u>cross the Newton city limit</u>; for example, between
     Newton & Hesston or North Newton.
  - Terms and schedules are set to avoid competing with private service, such as cabs.
- Minivan, wheelchair accessible, for medical trips.
   Trips may be Newton-to-Newton for wheelchair or medically qualified patients.
- Discounted fares are available if you are incomequalified.
  - Discounts for Harvey Interurban trips
  - Discounts for OT Cab Co Regular taxi fare is \$4.75 per ride. With the discount card, if income is below 185% of poverty level (1) person, the cost is \$3.50 per ride.

The routes and schedules of Harvey Interurban and some special services are set to avoid competing with private services such as taxi cabs.

- It may be necessary to take a cab in one direction and the special service in the other.
- If you qualify for special services, you may also qualify for a cab discount card.

Offers medical transportation Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.:

- Trips are filled on a first-call, first-served basis and reservations can be made up to one year in advance.
- Trips can be taken to Wichita, Hutchinson, or any destination in the surrounding area. The fare is \$8 within Newton\*, \$12 within Harvey County, and \$20 outside Harvey County.
- ♦ The van is equipped with a wheelchair ramp.
- Newton-to-Newton trips are only available for wheelchair patients. Escorts ride free.
